Garnett Williams dies at hospital

Mrs. Garnett L. Williams, of 110 East Walnut street, Monroe, died at 5:45 a.m. Sunday at the Adams county memorial hospital, following an extended illness. Mrs. Williams was employed as a nurse's aide at the local hospital for 15 years before retiring because of illness.

She was born in Hartford City Dec. 20, 1912, a daughter of Joseph and Ethel Brandyberry-Gettys, and was married to Darrell H. Williams Dec. 27, 1930.

Mrs. Williams was a member of the First Seventh Day Adventist church of Fort Wayne.
