DAVID EVERHART DIES OF HEART ATTACK AGED MAN PASSES AWAY AT MONROE-FUNERAL TO BE HELD THURSDAY

David Everhart, 83, pioneer resident of Adams county died suddenly of heart trouble at the home of his son, Absolem E. Everhart, in Monroe, Tuesday morning. Mr. Everhart was born in Adams county and spent most of his life in Washington township. Thirteen years ago, he moved to Monroe and had made his home here since that time.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Jane Everhart; one daughter, Mrs. John Crist, of Monroe; and two sons, Leroy Everhart, of Niles, Michigan, and Absolem E. Everhart of Monroe.

Funeral services will be held at the home of Absolem Everhart at 1:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon and at 2 o'clock at the Methodist church. The Rev. E.M. Foster will officiate. Burial will be made in the Smith cemetery.
