

RESULT IS FATAL:

Mrs. Matilda Wood Suffered Stroke of Paralysis Friday Evening

CAUSED HER DEATH:

At Her Home in Monroe -- Funeral Will be Held Sunday Morning

As the result of a stroke of paralysis, Mrs. Matilda Wood, residing at Monroe, passed into the great beyond at 5:30 Friday evening.

Mrs. Wood was born in Carroll county, Ohio, April 7, 1845, and was the daughter of William and Sarah Walton. They lived in Ohio until she was fourteen years of age, when the family moved to Adams County, where she has resided since.

Her first marriage was to Henry Hendricks. To this union was born two children, one having preceded the mother in death, the other one being Miss Jessie Hendricks.

After Mr. Hendricks' death she was again united in marriage to Oscar Walton (sic) (Wood is correct). Those left to mourn her loss besides the husband and daughter, are three sisters, Mrs. Joseph Johnson of Monroe, Mrs. Olive (sic) Hendricks of Monroe and Miss Maria Walton.

The funeral services will be held at 10 o'clock Sunday morning at the Methodist Church in Monroe and will be conducted by Rev. Phillips.

Interment will be made in the Smith cemetery.
