Services for Pamela Kay Blume, 28, Muncie, will be held Sunday at 2 p.m. at Zwick-Boltz & Jahn Funeral Home, Rev. Michael Brown officiating.

Miss Blume, a patient since March 25 at Methodist Hospital, Indianapolis, had been in critical condition since March 26 when she suffered a heart attack before she was to undergo a kidney transplant operation. She had been in a coma since that time and died at 8:15 a.m. Thursday.

A student at Ball State University, where she would have graduated this spring, Miss Blume was a former resident of Decatur.

Born in Decatur on August 10, 1957, she was the daughter of Edward A. Blume and Patricia A. Byrd-Blume. Survivors include the father of Greenfield; the mother, of Decatur; a sister, Sandra J. Blume, Indianapolis; a brother, Michael A. Blume, Bluffton; the maternal grandparents, Doyle and Leona Clevenger, Decatur and the paternal grandmother, Irene Blume, route 2, Decatur.
