ARTHUR C. FRUECHTE DIES AT FORT WAYNE

Funeral Services Monday Afternoon

Funeral services for Arthur C. Fruechte, 47, of Fort Wayne, native of this county and son of Mrs. Henry Fruechte of this city, will be held at 1:20 o'clock Monday afternoon at the C. M. Sloan funeral home, 1327 Wells street, Fort Wayne.

The Rev. John Heinstand and the Rev. Herbert Meussling will officiate, and burial will be in the Magley cemetery. The Scottish Rite will also assist in the services.

Mr. Fruechte's death occurred Friday afternoon at Methodist hospital following a six month's illness.

A veteran employe of the Fort Wayne General Electric Company, Mr. Fruechte was born in Preble township. He was graduated from the Decatur high school and had been employed as a mechanical draftsman at the G. E. for the past 26 years.

He was a member of the Decatur Masonic lodge, the Scottish Rite and the Mizpah Shrine, being secretary-treasurer of the latter organization's band. He was a member of the Grace Evangelical and Reformed church.

Surviving besides his mother, are his wife, Selma; a daughter, Sandra Jean and a son, Ronald Dean at home; two sisters, Mrs. Martin Worthman and Mrs. John Borne, and one brother, Franklin Fruechte, all of this city.
