## HENRY HILDEBRAND IS TAKEN BY DEATH

Henry E. Hildebrand, 81, retired farmer and resident of Kirkland Township most of his life, died suddenly at 11:15 a.m. Saturday at the home of a brother, Otto, in Preble.

He was born in Preble township, Jan. 30, 1884, a son of Henry and Wilhelmina Kruetzman-Hildebrand, and was never married. He made his home with his brother and sister-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Otto Hildebrand, who moved from Kirkland township to Preble 15 years ago.

Mr. Hildebrand was a member of the Salem United Church of Christ at Magley.

Surviving in addition to the brother is one sister, Mrs. Rosa Scherry, wife of the Rev. Otto Scherry of New Bavaria, Ohio.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday at the Zwick funeral home and at 2 p.m. at the Salem United Church of Christ Magley. The Rev. H. E. Settlage will officiate and burial will be in the church cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 7 p.m. today until time of the services.
