Irma C. Hildebrand, 63, route 2, died at 3:06 a.m. today in Adams County Memorial Hospital. She was ill 18 months and hospitalized 1 1/2 weeks.

She was born in Adams County on September 13, 1921 to Wade H. and Eva C. Ehling-McBarnes, and married Carl E. Hildebrand on June 15, 1946; he survives.

She was a housewife and formerly a beautician at Francile's Beauty Shop in Decatur in the early 1940's. She was also a member of Salem United Church of Christ in Magley, the church's women's guild, the Adams-Wells Association for Retarded Citizens (of which she was a board of directors member), and of Sunbeam Garden Club (immediate past president and a charter member).

Other survivors include two sons, Rev. Steve Hildebrand of Shelbyville and Tom Hildebrand, at home; a daughter, Mrs. Terry (Carolyn) Brendel of Valparaiso; three sisters, Mrs. Walter (Glennys) Gerber of Fort Wayne; Doris Brown of Port Richey, Florida; and Mrs. Eugene (Ruth) Sommer of route 2; two brothers, Vic McBarnes of Berne and Melvin McBarnes of route 2; and three grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday in Salem United Church of Christ, Rev. Floyd E. Vieth Jr. officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery.

Visiting hours at Zwick-Boltz & Jahn Funeral Home are 7-9 tonight and 2-5 and 7-9 p.m. Tuesday, and at the church one hour before the service. Preferred memorials are to the Adams-Wells Association for Retarded Citizens or Salem United Church of Christ.
