ROBERT EUGENE KELLEY

Robert Eugene Kelley, 39, Route 2, Decatur (Kirkland Township), a 21-year employee of the International Harvester Co., was dead on arrival at 5:11 a.m. today at the Adams County Memorial Hospital.

A second-trick employee and inspector at the Fort Wayne IH, he died of an apparent heart attack at his residence a short time after he arrived home from work.

He was a member of the Salem United Church of Christ at Magley and was a volunteer fireman for the Harvester Fire Department.

Born March 1, 1943, in Decatur, he was the son of Harold and Florine Gaskill-Kelley and was married to Linda Conrad October 10, 1964. She survives.

Also surviving are the parents, of Route 7, Decatur; two sons, Christopher H. Kelley, Route 4, Decatur, and Thomas E. Kelley, at home; a daughter, Tamara D. Kelley, at home; a grandson, Jesse L. Kelley; three brothers, Wendel H. Kelley, Route 5, Decatur; Jerry A. Kelley, Route 8, Decatur; Ron L. Kelley, Route 5, Decatur.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday at the Zwick, Boltz & Jahn Funeral Home, with Rev. Gerald Newbold and Rev. Brent Adams officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery.
