MAGLEY FARMER IS STRICKEN FATALLY

Ernest H. Kruetzman, 75, a retired farmer living near Magley, Adams county, died about 4 p.m. Monday from a heart attack while enroute to St. Joseph's hospital in Fort Wayne in the police ambulance.

Kruetzman became ill while on West Main street in Fort Wayne and entered a home to ask assistance. The ambulance was summoned and he was rushed to the hospital. Dr. A. P. Hattendorf, Allen county coroner, said he died from heart disease.

The body was removed to the Zwick funeral home at Decatur.

Several daughters living there survive.
