MRS. CAROLINE PECK DIES LAST EVENING

Mrs. Caroline Peck, 80, wife of Otto Peck, one and one-half miles north of Preble, died at 6 o'clock Tuesday evening at the Adams county memorial hospital. Mrs. Peck was taken to the hospital Tuesday morning after suffering a fall on the basement stairs of her home, when she sustained a fractured arm, and suffered from severe shock.

A lifelong resident of Preble township, she was a daughter of Henry and Fredericka Hilgeman-Peters, born Nov. 10, 1878. She was married to Otto Peck Dec. 17, 1905, and they celebrated their golden wedding anniversary in 1955.

Mrs. Peck was a member of the Salem Evangelical and Reformed church at Magley.

Surviving in addition to her husband are two daughters, Mrs. Glen (Irene) Girod of Preble township, and Mrs. Harry (Leona) Beavers of Washington township; one son, Walter B. Peck of Preble; six grandchildren and one sister, Miss Matilda Peters of Preble township.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Zwick funeral home and at 2 p.m. at the Salem Evangelical and Reformed church at Magley, the Rev. H. E. Settlege officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery. Friends may call at the home after 7 o'clock this evening until time of the services.
