Mrs. Alma P. Reppert, 80, widow of Rev. Charles Reppert, and a former resident of Decatur, died Saturday afternoon at the Luther Hospital in Eau Claire, Wisconsin.

She was a resident of Adams County for many years and was a member of the Zion United Church of Christ in Decatur. She was a former resident of 108 S. Third St.
