**MARTIN REPPERT DIES WEDNESDAY EVENING**  
**Funeral Services Saturday Afternoon**

Martin Reppert, 79, a retired farmer living at Magley, died at 7:30 o'clock Wednesday evening at the Adams county memorial hospital following a week's illness.

He was born in Preble township Oct. 12, 1876, a son of Peter and Lisette Beineke-Reppert, and lived in Preble township until retiring from his farm in 1941. He was married Nov. 4, 1904, to Martha Kruetzman, who preceded him in death Dec. 9, 1948.

Mr. Reppert was a member of the Magley Evangelical and Reformed church.

There are no immediate survivors. A son, Milton Reppert, was killed in a motorcycle accident in 1940, and two brothers also preceded in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1 p.m. Saturday at the Zwick funeral home and at 1:30 p.m. at the Magley Evangelical and Reformed church, the Rev. H. E. Settlege officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 7 o'clock this evening.
