## MILTON E. SCHERRY DIES THIS MORNING

Milton E. Scherry, 69, of Decatur route 2, retired farmer residing one-half mile west of Preble, died at 9:40 a.m. today at the Adams county memorial hospital, where he had been a patient five days.

He was born in Preble township, Feb. 17, 1901, a son of Daniel and Lydia Reppert-Scherry, and was life-long resident of the township. He was married to Ella M. Worthman July 25, 1926.

Mr. Scherry was a member of the Salem United Church of Christ at Magley.

Surviving are his wife; one daughter, Mrs. Arthur (Vera Jane) Adam of Magley; one son, Rolland Scherry of Decatur route 2; three sisters, Mrs. Losier (Alma) Eckrote of Fort Wayne, Mrs. Lester (Marie) Cowans of Decatur route 4, and Mrs. Gerald (Marcella) Cook of Decatur route 6; and five grandchildren.
