FORMER COUNTY RESIDENT DIES

Mrs. Sarah Scherry, 81, of Upper Sandusky, O., sister of Edward F. Jaberg of Decatur, died at 10 p.m. Friday in Fair Haven Church Home, Upper Sandusky. She had been in failing health two years.

Born in Preble Township on August 26, 1892, she was the daughter of Samuel and Caroline Bloemker-Jaberg, and was married to Rev. Albert Scherry on June 10, 1916. He died in 1968.

Surviving are three children, Mrs. Walter (Codelia) Manger, of Baltimore, Md.; Mrs. Richard (Elnora) Job of Xenia, O.; Mrs. Robert (Virginia) Jones of Indianapolis; one sister, Mrs. Wilfred (Ellen) McPeak of Upper Sandusky; two brothers, Edward F. Jaberg of Decatur, Daniel Jaberg of Fond du Lac, Wisc.; seven grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren. One son, LeRoy, preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be held Monday at 1 p.m. at the Same [sic] United Church of Christ, Magley, with Rev. Matthew Worthman officiating. Burial will be in the Salem United Church of Christ cemetery. The body will lie in state at the church from 12 noon to 1 p.m. Monday. Preferred memorials are to the Fair Haven Church Home.
