## ADOLPH SMITH DIES AT LOCAL HOSPITAL.

Adolph E. Smith, 63, of Monroe, a lifelong resident of Adams county, died at 12:45 p.m. Tuesday at the Adams county memorial hospital following a weeks' illness.

He was born in Adams county May 2, 1900, a son of John and Elizabeth Neuenschwander-Smith. His wife, the former Alice Helmrick, preceded him in death in 1957.

Mr. Smith, an employe of the General Electric Co. in Fort Wayne, was a member of St. John's United Church of Christ at Vera Cruz.

Surviving are two sons, Harvey Smith of Monroe, and John Ray Smith of Leo; two daughters, Mrs. Anly L. (Barbara) Han?, Jr., with her Army husband in Germany, and Mrs. Frank (Florence) Williams of Birmingham, Ala.; 11 grandchildren; one great-grandchild; four brothers, Alfred Smith of Monroe, Godfred Smith of Geneva, John Smith of Bluffton, and Fred Smith of Fort Wayne, and one sister, Mrs. Charles (Bertha) Myers of Holland, Mich. One brother is deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Saturday at the St. John's United Church of Christ at Vera Cruz, Dr. Meredith Sprunger and Rev. Robert Oleson officiating. Burial will be in the Magley Reformed church cemetery. The body was removed to the Winteregg-Linn funeral home where friends may call after 7 p.m. Thursday until 11 a.m. Saturday, after which the body will lie in state at the church until time of the services.
