June E. Witte, 73, of Decatur, died at 1:55 p.m. Tuesday in the extended care unit of Adams County Memorial Hospital after a long illness.

She was born on September 6, 1930, in Adams County, to Walter F. and Susanna M. Conrad Reppert.

She married Gerhard L. Witte on July 22, 1951; he survives.

She retired from the Woodcrest Nursing Center in 1995 and previously worked at the former Lakeside Manor in Decatur (now Evergreen Court Apartments). She also was a charter member of the Merrier Mondays Home Economics Club.
