Bublitz and for the past two years had resided in Kingsland, Texas. A short time ago Rev. Bublitz received a call to a congregation in Michigan, and accepted it, and accompanied by Mrs. Bublitz was on his way there. They stopped over a week ago last Thursday to visit Mrs. Bublitz's mother. Surviving Mrs. Bublitz leaves the husband, her mother, and the following brothers and sisters: Charles, Fred, Theodore and Christ, of Fort Wayne; William Mailand of Nebraska; Louis Mailand of Decatur; Mrs. W. W. Zwick of Nebraska; and Mrs. F. Droege, of this city. Funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock, sun time, at the residence of her mother, and at 2 o'clock at the St. John's Lutheran church in Adams county.
