

## **Jean M. Bultemeier**

March 31, 1928 - September 16, 2010

Jean M. Bultemeier, 82 years old of Hoagland, Indiana, passed away at 1:13 p.m. on Thursday, September 16, 2010 in the Village of Heritage located in Monroeville, Indiana.
