

## LOUIS BULTEMEIER DIES SUDDENLY

### MARION TOWNSHIP FARMER SUCCUMBS TO HEART FAILURE

Louis Bultemeier, aged fifty-eight years, died suddenly at his residence in Marion township Friday afternoon at 5 o'clock. Coroner J. E. Stults and Deputy Coroner George Studer were called to the home shortly after the death to determine its cause. They found that Mr. Bultemeier had died of heart trouble. Mr Bultemeier together with his son-in-law hauled wheat during the afternoon and afterwards repaired his wagon. While he was engaged in this work, Mr. Bultemeier dropped over dead. Surviving relatives are two sons, Edward of Decatur, and Herman, who lived with his father and four daughters, Mrs. C. H. Oetting, Lydia, Clara and Ella. Mr. Bultemeier was a member of the St John's Lutheran church.
