

**Fort Wayne Journal Gazette, Allen County, Indiana; Jan. 24, 1914**

Mrs. Anna Hoppe, aged 85 years, the widow of Henry Hoppe, and a pioneer resident of Allen county, died Thursday afternoon at the family residence in Marion township, where she had lived for the past sixty-three years. Her death was due to complications and followed a prolonged illness. Mrs. Hoppe was a native of Germany and came to this country at the age of twenty-six years. She was a member of St. John's Lutheran church and was widely known. Surviving she leaves six children: Fred Hoppe, Mrs. Ernest Brandtmiller and Mrs. Barney Koeneman, of Marion township; Henry and Herman Hoppe and Mrs. Fred Furian, of this city. She also leaves five grandchildren and two brothers, Herman and Henry Wetgen, of Bremen, Germany.

Funeral services will occur Sunday afternoon at 1:45 o'clock (sun time) from the residence and at 2:15 o'clock from St. John's Lutheran church.
