Mr. Kaiser was widely known in Allen county as a farmer, having retired several years ago. He made his home with the son for two and one-half years. He had been in ill health for about one year. Surviving are the widow Mrs. Marie Kaiser, four daughters, Mrs. George Hilsimier and Mrs. Simon Hilsimier, both of Wells county; Mrs. Martin Forsch of Marion township, and Mrs. Henry Moldthan of Hoagland; two sons, Henry at whose home he died and Ervin of Fort Wayne and 15 grandchildren. The body was removed to Scheumann & Sons' funeral parlors and will be returned to the Henry Kaiser home this afternoon at 4 o'clock. Funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 3 o'clock (DST) at the home on the Monroeville road and at 2:30 o'clock at St John's Lutheran church, Rev Richard Truelesch officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery.
