Frederick Mailand, a well known farmer of Adams county, died Wednesday at his home, fourteen miles south of Fort Wayne, after a long illness. He was seventy-five years of age and was born in Germany but came to America fifty-eight years ago. He leaves his wife and these children: Mrs. Sophia Schick (s/b Zwick) and William Mailand of Lincoln, Neb; Mrs. Fred Droege and Fred, Christ and Theodore Mailand of Fort Wayne; Louis Mailand of Decatur and Henry, Charles and Mary who reside at the family home. Mr. Mailand went to Adams county in 1846 and he proved very successful as a farmer. He amassed a comfortable fortune and beside his holding in Adams county, he owned a large tract of land near Lincoln, Neb. He was a member of the German Lutheran church and he was held in high esteem by the people of the neighborhood in which he lived. The decedent was a brother-in-law of Undertaker F H Scheumann of this city. The funeral will be held Sunday morning at 9:30 o'clock at the residence and at 10 o'clock at St John's Lutheran church near Decatur. The Rev Houge (?) of Bingen, will officiate.
