PROMINENT DECATUR WOMAN IS DEAD

Mrs. Louis Mailand Passes Away After Long Illness From Tuberculosis

DECATUR, Ind. March 20 - Marie, wife of Louis Mailand, died this morning at 11:10 at her home on North Second street, after a several years' illness with tuberculosis, that assumed a serious form only in the past few weeks. The deceased was thirty-one years of age, and was born October 28, 1877, at Leipsic, Germany, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Hugo Grathner, who still reside at Leipsic, where also lives the one brother and sister of the deceased. About seven years ago, she came to this country to live, having relatives in this county. She was married September 27, 1903, to Louis Mailand and the marriage proved unusually happy. Mrs. Mailand had a cheerful disposition and her many womanly traits and excellent qualities made her a friend to everyone. The funeral will be held Tuesday noon at 11:30 from the home and 12 o'clock from the Zion Lutheran Church, on West Monroe street, the Rev. J. H. Klausung officiating. At 3 o'clock the body will be taken to St. John's church, where another service will be held.
