

**Fort Wayne News Sentinel, Allen County, IN; March 15, 1921**

Mrs. Wilhelmina Mailand, aged 77 years, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Ferdinand Droege 1001 West Creighton avenue at 9 o'clock this morning of pneumonia. She had been seriously ill for three days. Mrs. Mailand was born in Germany but from the age of two years until six years ago she resided on a farm in Adams county.
