

Fort Wayne News, Allen County, Indiana; June 19, 1919

William Henry Mailand, aged 17 years, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Mailand, of Marion township, died at 4 o'clock yesterday afternoon from leakage of the heart at the home of his parents on the Decatur road, ten miles south of this city. He had suffered from the fatal malady for four months and had been confined to bed for four weeks.

He was a graduate of the tighth [sic] grade of the public schools and a student at the International Business college, of this city, from which he would have graduated in a few months. The parents and two sisters and brothers survive: Aldrine, Louella, Herman and Herbert Mailand, all at home.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the residence, and at 2:30 o'clock from the St. John's Lutheran church at Bingham, the Rev. Mr. Bishop, officiating.
