MRS CHARLOTTE SCHEIMANN DEAD

Resident of Marion Township Succumbs To Fever

Descendent (sic) was the Widow of William Scheimann

She was a Native of Germany, But Came to America When But Two Years of Age

Mrs. Charlotte Scheimann, widow of William Scheimann, died Friday morning at her home in Marion township after an illness of typhoid fever. Mrs. Scheimann was one of the best known of the German-American residents of Allen county. Her age was 60 years, 5 months and 1 day. She was born in Preuss, Minden, Germany, but came to America with her parents when but two years of age. She lived for some years in Adam county but after her marriage to William Scheimann she moved to the farm in Marion township where her death occurred. Her husband died about nine years ago. Surviving Mrs. Scheimann are eight children: City Councilman Fred Scheimann of Fort Wayne; Martin, Bertha and Minnie Scheimann, Mrs. Fred Gable, Mrs. Robert Gengz, Mrs. Ernst Schroeder, and Mrs. Gustave Prange. The funeral will be held from the family home in Marion township, Monday afternoon at 1 o'clock, the Rev Mr. Huge officiating.
