

FALL DOWN STAIRS CAUSES HER DEATH

Mrs. Wilhelmina Gallmeyer Dies As Result of Accident

Had Been in Fort Wayne Visiting Her Niece Only a Few Days.

Mrs. Wilhelmina Gallmeyer, for sixty years a resident of Adams county, died at the home of her niece, Mrs. Robert Bengs, 2329 Force street, at 8 o'clock Friday morning as the result of an accident. Mrs. Gallmeyer came to Fort Wayne a week ago yesterday to visit her relatives and on the following day fell down the cellar steps, fracturing several ribs and causing other injuries. Complications, together with heart trouble, set in, which eventually caused her death. The deceased was sixty-seven years of age and when seven years old came to America from Windham Germany, with her parents. The family settled in Adams county where Mrs. Gallmeyer lived until a week ago. Mrs. Gallmeyer was twice married. Her first husband, Diederich Scheiman, died nearly forty years ago. Some time afterward she married Conrad Gallmeyer, and he too preceded her to the grave thirty years ago. Two daughters and four sons survive her. They are Mrs. Ferdinand Bultemeyer and Mrs. Wm. Schroeder of Marion township; Fred Gallmeyer, residing in the west and Charles, William and August Gallmeyer of Adams county. The deceased was a member of the Lutheran church and during her life was kind and charitable.
