

## **Fort Wayne Journal Gazette, Allen County, IN; September 13, 1918**

Wilhelmina Scheumann, aged 74 years, 4 months and 14 days, widow of the late Detrick Scheumann, died yesterday afternoon at 3 o'clock at her home twelve miles south of this city. Death resulted from a stroke of paralysis which she suffered about four weeks ago.

The decedent was born in Preusminden, Germany, and came to this country with her parents at a very early age. She practically spent her life in Allen county. Her husband died about twenty-six years ago.

She is survived by the following children: Charles, Dedrick, William, Theodore and Martin, Mrs Minnie Scheumann, Mrs Sophia Fruechtenicht, Mrs Chas Dirkson of Hobson, Mont. The others are residents of Allen county; also Matilda Auman and Mrs. Julia Seddelmeyer, also one brother, Will Bradtmiller of Adams township. She leaves two sisters, Mrs. Sophia Berning of Adams township and Mrs. Lizzetta Bultemeyer of Fort Wayne. Funeral arrangements will be announced later.
