

Hugo Bulmahn
(November 16, 1914 - February 13, 2007)

Hugo Bulmahn, 92 years old, a former resident of the Preble, Indiana area and a recent resident of LaBelle, Florida, passed away at 12:30 a.m. on Tuesday, February 13, 2007 in the Southwest Florida Regional Medical Center in Fort Myers, Florida.



Hugo was born on November 16, 1914 in Adams County, Indiana, the son of the late Fred Bulmahn and the late Louise (Meyer) Bulmahn. He married Florence R. Marbach on June 21, 1942 in the Immanuel Lutheran Church, Union Township, rural Decatur, Indiana, and she survives.
