(January 1, 1929 - February 28, 2010)

Harold F. Fritch, 81 years old of Decatur, Indiana, passed away at 7:20 p.m. on Sunday, February 28, 2010 in the Adams Memorial Hospital located in Decatur, Indiana.



Harold was born on Tuesday, January 1, 1929 in Allen County, Indiana the son of the late Henry F. Fritch and the late Esther (Weber) Fritch. He married the late Bernice J. Ehlerding on July 26, 1958 in St. Paul Lutheran Church, Preble; and she passed away on June 21, 2002.
