WILLIAM KIRCHNER IS DEAD IN ADAMS COUNTY

William R. Kirchner, eighty-seven years old, a pioneer of Adams county, and who is well known here, died Friday at his home in Preble township, that county. Mr. Kirchner had resided in Adams county for more than sixty years, was township assessor for twenty-two years and was one of the founders of the Lutheran church near his home. He is survived by three daughters, all of whom reside in Fort Wayne. They are Mrs. Louis Stetter, of Swinney avenue; Mrs. Pauline Yahn of Miner street and Mrs. William Fuhrman of Leith street. William Yahn is a grandson, Mrs. Lottie Kirchner, a sister-in-law, and Gottlieb Kirchner a brother of the deceased.
