Hubert E. Krick, 64, 727 High St., died at 11:50 p.m. Saturday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital. He had been seriously ill for the past four months.

Mr. Krick, who retired from the General Electric Co. in 1976, was a veteran of World War II, having served in the European Theatre. A member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Preble, he held memberships in the G. E. Quarter Century Club and American Legion Post No. 43, and was a representative of the Lutheran Layman's League.

Born on August 19, 1916 in Decatur to George W. Krick and Malinda Gause-Krick, he was married on August 1, 1948, to the former Leona Koenemann, who survives.

Also surviving are two sisters, Mrs. Helen Hawkins and Mrs. Charles (Eileen) Garwood, both of Decatur, and three brothers, all of whom reside in Decatur, Doyle H. Krick, Roger L. Krick, and Larry Krick. One sister and one brother preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday in St. Paul Lutheran Church, Preble, Rev. Carl B. Schultz in charge, and burial will be in the church cemetery.
