Clarence Sebesta, 75, of Decatur, a World War II veteran of the Merchant Marine, died Saturday, June 24, 2000, at Adams County Memorial Hospital. The Chicago native was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in rural Decatur and had worked at Kraft Foods for 38 years before retiring in 1987.
