Wilma Werling, 89, rural Craigville, died at 6:50 p.m. Saturday at Adams County Memorial Hospital after having been in failing health the past year.

A homemaker, she was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Preble; a charter member of the Ladies Aid of the church (member for over 50 years), and of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League.

She was born on October 5, 1908, in Adams County and was the daughter of Dan and Marie Danmeyer Wefel. She was married to Reinhard Werling on April 7, 1929; he died on February 5, 1979.
