

## **Fort Wayne Weekly Sentinel, Allen County, Indiana; Jan. 17, 1906**

Diedrich Buuck, a pioneer resident of Adams county, died at his home in Friedheim at 1:30 Sunday morning at the age of 71 years, 9 months and 24 days. Death was due to advanced age and a complication of diseases from which he had been suffering for many months.

Mr. Buuck was a native of Germany, but came with his parents to America when but a babe, and the family settled upon the farm upon which Mr. Buuck spent the remainder of his long life. He is survived by the wife, eight sons and three daughters. The children are Fred, Otto, and Adolph, of Freidheim; Henry Buuck and Mrs. Sophie Jaebker, of Preble; Rev. August Buuck, of Van Wert county, Ohio; Mrs. Anna Boese, of Decatur; Mrs. Albert Huser, Albert and Chris Buuck of Fort Wayne; and Addison and Paul Buuck, who are attending Addison seminary, at Addison, Ill. There are twenty-six grandchildren, and other relatives, including two brothers, Louis Buuck of Freidheim, Fred Buuck of Kenosha, Wis., and two sisters, Mrs. Louise Werfelman, of Chicago and Mrs. Henry WoebeKing, of Woodburn, this county.

Funeral services Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock from the residence and at 10:30 from the Lutheran church at Friedheim.
