Waldo Conrad, 87 years old of Decatur, Indiana, passed away at 8:25 p.m. on Friday, May 24, 2013 in the Woodcrest Nursing Center located in Decatur.

Waldo was born on Friday, January 8, 1926 in Adams County, Indiana the son of the late Martin Conrad and the late Frieda (Bauermeister) Conrad.
