Prominent Adams County Man, Born In This City, Dead

DECATUR, Ind., July 1 - Suffering from a stroke of paralysis, William Conrad, a pioneer and one of the best known men of Preble township, died Saturday at the family home, near Freidheim. Mr. Conrad was born in Fort Wayne, Dec. 12, 1836, but when a mere child, the parents, Mr. and Mrs. George Conrad, moved to Preble township. In April Mr. and Mrs. Conrad celebrated their golden wedding anniversary. He is survived by the widow and five children - August Conrad, of near Friedheim; Ernest Conrad, of Root township; William D. Conrad, of Kansas; Louis Conrad, of California and Frederick Conrad, of Kansas City. One brother, Christian Conrad, survives and resides in Preble township, near the home of the deceased. Charles Conrad, another brother, died only a few weeks ago. Mr. Conrad's sickness was brought on by a cold contracted some days ago while attending the funeral of some friend in Allen county.
