HAROLD GALLMEYER DIES THIS MORNING Funeral Services Monday Afternoon

Harold Gallmeyer, 48, a resident of Preble township most of his life, died at 4 o'clock this morning at his home in Preble. He had been in failing health for several years and seriously ill for the past six weeks.

He was born in Milwaukee, Wis., May 25, 1909, a son of Henry and Emelia Reese-Gallmeyer, and was married to Emelie Buuck Dec. 7, 1940. He had been employed by Fruehauf Trailer Sales at Fort Wayne since 1950. The family moved to Preble one year ago.

Mr. Gallmeyer was a member of the Zion Lutheran church at Friedheim.

Surviving in addition to his wife are two sons, Henry and James, at home; one daughter, Mrs. Richard Steffey of Fort Wayne; a half-sister, Mrs. Adolph Kiefer; and two grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1 p.m. Monday at the Zwick funeral home and at 2:30 p.m. at the Zion Lutheran church at Friedheim, the Rev. A. A. Fenner officiating.
