

FATAL STROKE

William Heckman, Preble Township Farmer, Died This Morning at 2:30.

ILL OVER A YEAR

Was Sixty-two Years of Age – Native of County – Funeral Tuesday.

William Heckman, aged sixty-two years, eleven months and nineteen days, a prominent farmer of Preble township, died this morning at 2:30 o'clock, after being bedfast more than a year, since receiving a paralytic stroke.

Mr. Heckman was a native of this county, born October 6, 1852, being a son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Heckman. The father is deceased, but the mother is living. His wife, who was formerly Miss Mary Jaebker, is also living, as are the following children: Christena Dohn, Seattle, Wash; Bety, at home; Rev. E. A. Heckman, Abilene, Texas; Martin, at home. There are also two brothers and two sisters.

The funeral will be Tuesday afternoon at one o'clock at the Friedheim (sic) Lutheran church, the Rev. Preuss officiating.
