

**PREBLE TWP. WOMAN DIES**

Mrs. Louise Koenemann Dies This Morning At Preble Twp. Home

Mrs. Louise Eickhoff-Koenemann, 81, of Preble township, widow of Henry Koenemann, died at her home at 6:30 o'clock this morning. Death was due to complications and old age. Mrs. Koenemann had been bedfast for the past three weeks.
