

**Decatur Daily Democrat, Adams County, Indiana; Monday, April 12, 1982**

Gustav Miller, 91, a former resident of Rt. 1, Decatur (Preble Township) and a resident of the Lutheran Home in Kendallville since October of 1973, died there at 1:50 p.m. Saturday.

A retired carpenter, he had been an appraiser for the German Mutual Fire Insurance Co. for many years. He was also a lifelong member of the Zion Lutheran Church (Friedheim) where he had held most offices at one time or another.

Born in Preble Township on Sept. 25, 1890, he was the son of Henry and Louise Miller, and was married on June 3, 1915, to Martha Conrad; she died March 20, 1958.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Elbert (Leona) Berning, Rt. 4, Fort Wayne and Mrs. Edwin (Olga) Reifsteck, Rt. 4, Ossian; a sister, Mrs. Walter (Clara) Bultemeier, Rt. 1, Decatur; a brother, Paul Miller, Rt. 4, Ossian; six grandchildren; and one great-grandson. One brother, Henry, preceded him in death.
