OTTO OSTERMEYER IS TAKEN BY DEATH

Funeral Services Thursday Afternoon

Otto Ostermeyer, 50, well known Preble township farmer, died at 10:15 o'clock Monday night at his home three miles north of Magley. Death was caused by heart trouble and complications, following an illness of 18 months.

He was born in Preble township June 1, 1893, the son of Fred and Maria Eichkoff-Ostermeyer, and spent his entire lifetime in that township. He was a member of the Friedheim Lutheran church and for 12 years drove a township school bus.

He was married to Adelinde Reese April 24, 1921. Surviving are the widow; the father, living in Preble township; one sister, Mrs. Martin Gallmeyer of Wells county, and three brothers, Martin Ostermeyer of Wells county, Edwin of Fort Wayne and Theodore of Preble township.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday at the home and at 2:30 o'clock at the church, with Rev. Walter J. Luecke officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery. The body will be removed from the Zwick funeral home to the residence and may be viewed after 7 o'clock this evening.
