

MRS. EMMA PREUSS DIES THIS MORNING

Widow of Lutheran Pastor Dies Today

Mrs. Emma Preuss, 90, widow of the Rev. C. B. Preuss, Lutheran pastor, died at 4:30 o'clock this morning at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Paul Buuck, New Haven, where she had resided for the past 11 years.

She was born near Avilla Oct. 21, 1867.

Surviving in addition to Mrs. Buuck are three other daughters, Mrs. Emma Peters of Auburn, Mrs. M. C.
