Mr. Blossom and his family started for Michigan about the first of January, to visit friends and locate, if the country proved desirable. His wife and child were unwell when they left and were soon prostrated with what proved a fatal illness to both. Their remains were brought to Monmouth, where they were interred on Tuesday. Mrs. Blossom was the daughter of Aaron and Olive Hill, of this county, both of whom deceased some time since. She was a respected member of the Baptist Church, at Monmouth.
