Mrs. Clara R. Adams Dies This Morning

Mrs. Clara Regina Adams, 78, of 119 East Rugg street, died at 9:30 o'clock this morning at Adams county memorial hospital. Death was attributed to complications. She had been seriously ill two weeks.

She was born at Hessen Cassell April 30, 1883, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Sorg. Her husband, William Adams, preceded her in death.
