Miss Rose Appelman Dies This Morning

Miss Rose Appelman, 78, member of a prominent Adams county family, died at 3 o'clock this morning at the family home west of Decatur on rural route 4. She had been ill for six months with complications.

She was born in Adams county Oct. 11, 1881, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Appelman, Sr., and had never married.

Miss Appelman was a member of the St. Mary's Catholic church, the Rosary society and the Third Order of St. Francis.

Surviving are one sister, Miss Lena Appelman, and one brother, Joseph Appelman, both of whom reside at the family home. She was preceded in death by two brothers, George and John Appelman, and four sisters, Mrs. Anna ??wald, Mrs. Elizabeth Loshe, Mrs. Theresa Schafer and Mrs. Mary Faurote.
