### **Fred J. Bashara Dies Last Evening**

Fred J. Bashara, 64, manager of the cafeteria at the Decatur General Electric Co. plant for the past 20 years, died at 8:25 o'clock Thursday evening at the Adams county memorial hospital.

Mr. Bashara, who moved to Decatur when he assumed management of the cafeteria 20 years ago, suffered a heart attack last Saturday at his home, 333 South Fifth street, and had been hospitalized since that time.

Born in Fort Wayne Feb. 2, 1900, he was a son of Joseph and Sarah Corey-Bashara. He and his wife, Mamie, were married April 30, 1938.

Mr. Bashara was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church, the Knights of Columbus, and the Moose and Elks lodges.

Surviving in addition to his wife are one daughter, Mrs. Gary (Marian) Giessler of Decatur, and one brother, George Bashara of Sanford, Fla. Two brothers and two sisters preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9 a.m. Monday at St. Mary's Catholic church, with the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Simeon Schmitt officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery. The body was removed to the Winteregg-Linn funeral home, where friends may call after 2 p.m. Saturday until time of the services. The Holy Name society will recite the rosary at 7:30 p.m. Sunday, and the Loyal Order of Moose will hold memorial rites at 7:30 p.m. Saturday. (Thursday, 4-2-1964)
