Jerome Bosse Dies In San Francisco

Jerome J. Bosse, 66, member of a prominent Decatur family, and resident of this city for much of his life, died Friday morning at General hospital in San Francisco.

Mr. Bosse had resided in San Francisco for the past 20 years, with his latest address at 825 Howard street.

He was born in Decatur Feb. 25, 1899, a son of John W. and Kathryn Durkin-Bosse, and was never married. He was associated with his father in the outdoor advertising business for 25 years prior to moving to California.

Mr. Bosse was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church in Decatur.

Only survivors are two nephews, Dr. Robert Kohne of Lafayette, and Thomas Bosse of Cleveland Heights, O., and two nieces, Mrs. L. A. O'Donnell of Springfield, Va., and Mrs. Joseph Barbieri, Jr., of Fort Wayne. A brother, Ed A. Bosse, and a sister, Mrs. Leona Kohne, preceded him in death.

The body will be brought to the Gillig, Doan and Sefton funeral home. Funeral arrangements are incomplete.
