DEATH TAKES BOSSE INFANT

Small Son of Mr. and Mrs. Ed Bosse Dies

John B. Bosse, 11-month old son of Mr. and Mrs. Edmund A. Bosse of Decatur, died at 5 o'clock Tuesday evening at the Riley hospital in Indianapolis. Death was caused by streptococci septicemia.

The child had been a patient in the Indianapolis hospital for the past 10 days.

The infant was born October 19, 1936, the son of Edmund and Laura Lauby-Bosse. Surviving besides the parents are a brother, Thomas David, at home; and the grandfather, W. J. Bosse of Decatur. One brother, William, is deceased.

Funeral services will be held at the St. Mary's Catholic church at Decatur Friday morning at nine o'clock, with the Rev. Father J. J. Seimetz, pastor, officiating. Burial will be made in the St. Joseph Cemetery.
