Lawrence A. Braun Is Taken By Death

Lawrence A. Braun, 67, well known retired Adams county farmer of route 4, Decatur, died at 2:30 o'clock Friday afternoon at a hospital in Rochester, N.Y. Death was caused by a cerebral hemorrhage.

Mr. and Mrs. Braun were on a trip to the east when he was stricken one week ago.

He was born in Adams county March 25, 1893, a son of Mr. and Mrs. John Braun, and was married to Matilda Rumschlag Feb. 25, 1919.

Mr. Braun was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church, the Knights of Columbus, Holy Name Society, and the Third Order of St. Francis.
